Dr. Ambedkar Foundation, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India is providing Doctoral Fellowships under the scheme of Dr. Ambedkar Chair at Indira Gandhi National Tribal University, (Central University), Amarkantak, M.P –

1) Nature of Assistance

2) Target Beneficiaries

- a) The candidates registered for a Ph.D. degree in the parent university/institute and under the Chair Professor /Assistant Professor of Dr. Ambedkar Chair, IGNTU.
- b) The scheme is dedicated to the social-economic transformation, thereby including the marginalized and the socially and economically backward groups. Therefore, as far as possible, persons belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Classes, or those belonging to other weaker Sections of the society may be preferred while selected as the Doctoral Fellows.
- c) A fair try will be made for the selection of women candidates as per the selection criteria.

3) Research Topics

Research topics can be Inter-Disciplinary on the present and past of the social, cultural, economic and biological aspects of the deprived people and on the justice and empowerment of the weaker and oppressed section of the population. The research includes must be field-based work and be supervised by the Chair Professor/Assistant Professor.

The broad disciplines of study area within the domain of Tribal Development, Socio, Cultural and Economics of Tribal Development/Vulnerabilities, Dr. Ambedkar thoughts & Philosophy and related area, Gender & Tribal and other related area.

4) Measurable Indicators

The Chair Professor/ Chair Assistant Professor will evaluate the work of the researcher through the following evaluation method:

- a. Six Months (Fieldwork and Preparation of Literature Review)
- b. Second Six Months (Progress report and publication of a research paper)
- c. Third Six Months (Field work and Preparing a draft synopsis of the Research)
- d. Fourth Six Months (Fieldwork, preparation of synopsis of the Research and Progress Report)

- e. Fifth Six Month (Pre-Submission Presentation/Thesis Writing and publication of research paper)
- f. Sixth Six Month (ThesisSubmission)

5) Fellowship period

Doctoral fellows will get the fellowship for three years to be extendable by one year on extreme ground and up to satisfactory progress of work to be duly certified by the Chair Professor with justification and approval by Director, DAF. The proposal of extension, if any, shall be forwarded to Director DAF through Chair Professors before six months of completion of the fellowship.

6) Minimum Eligibility

- i. Candidates must have secured a minimum 55% in Post-Graduation or equivalent grades in the relevant subject. Five per cent (5%) relaxation of marks will be given to the SC/ST candidates. The submission of Marks Sheet, particularly of Graduation and Post-Graduation are mandatory otherwise the candidate shall be considered as Not Eligible.
- ii. NET/SLET will carry weightage in the assessment of research proposal.

Selection/ Communication:

The selection must be made based on merit and proposal of the work for the cause of the vulnerable/ marginalized communities. The proposal should consist of 2000-3000 words, which should be interlinked with the subject domain of the Doctoral fellow and the thrust area of the chair. Only short-listed candidates will be communicated through email.
